



WILDLIFE HUNTING POLICY

The Wildlife Hunting Policy consists of a set of rules and regulations developed to ensure the protection of wildlife and its sustainable use. This policy covers hunting seasons, huntable species, hunting methods, and hunting tools.

In Türkiye, the Wildlife Hunting Policy is governed by **Law No. 4915 on Land Hunting** and the regulations enacted under this law. The primary objective of this policy is to ensure the protection of wildlife and its sustainable use.

Hunting activities may only be carried out in designated areas and during specified periods. Huntable species are determined by the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, and hunting methods and tools are regulated accordingly.

The Wildlife Hunting Policy serves as an important instrument for the protection of wildlife and its sustainable management. Through the effective implementation of this policy, wildlife populations are kept under control and wildlife resources are ensured to be used sustainably.

- Ensuring the protection of wildlife and its sustainable use
- Determining hunting seasons and huntable species based on scientific data
- Preventing hunting methods and tools from causing adverse impacts on wildlife
